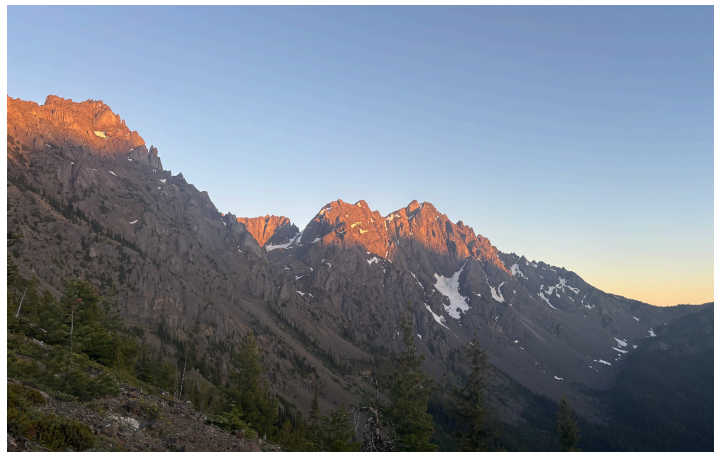

Washington joins carbon market with CA and Quebec

Washington, California, and Quebec announced the merge of their carbon markets late last week. They should be operating a joint market by 2027.

The Climate Commitment Act launched Washington’s carbon market in 2021. A carbon market requires the state’s biggest greenhouse gas emitters to buy allowances for their emissions. The state is lowering the amount of allowances sold, which will force polluters to pay more to pollute or cut their emissions. The program has raised over \$4 billion since its inception. By combining the market with Quebec and Canada, our state’s effort to make an impact on a global scale is much more likely to be realized. A broader market means more allowances and companies, which can slow down price spikes. Read more [here](#).
